Recognizing Your Achievements

At CGCS, we value the hard work you put into your studies and experiences. Our Diploma in International Volunteering is not just a qualification—it can also be a stepping stone to further academic opportunities.

What is Credit Transfer?

• Credit transfer allows you to apply the credits you've earned in this program towards another program at a different institution, helping you advance more quickly in your academic journey.

How It Works

- **Earned Credits:** Our Diploma in International Volunteering is a Level 3 qualification with 41 credits. These credits are recognized in the UK and can be transferred to other institutions, depending on their policies.
- **Global Recognition:** Typically, 41 CGCS credits equate to 20 ECTS credits or 10 US credits, making your qualification valuable across various educational systems.
- **Consult First:** Before enrolling in a new program, consult with the admissions office of your intended institution to understand how your credits can be applied.

Why Transfer Credits?

- Advance Your Education: Use your credits to gain advanced standing in a degree program, potentially shortening the time needed to complete your studies.
- **Expand Opportunities:** Credits earned through our diploma can open doors to studying abroad or joining international programs.

Steps to Transfer Your Credits

- 1. Complete Your Diploma: Finish the program and earn your credits.
- 2. Get Your Transcript: Request your transcript from CGCS.
- 3. Consult Your New Institution: Discuss the credit transfer process with your new school.
- 4. Submit Your Application: Provide your transcript and other required documents.
