Program Schedules During Lunar New Year (Tet)

Week-by-Week Overview

- Jan 20-24: Work Mon-Fri (Culture Week, Medical Placement, Special Needs, Kindergarten, or Special Program).
- Jan 27-31: Work Mon, Tue, Fri (no program Wed and Thu). The special program includes meal preparation for the elderly and underprivileged groups.
- Feb 3-7: Work Mon-Fri (Special Program).
- Feb 10-14: Work Mon-Fri (Primary school or English center).

Activities During Tet

- Assist in meal preparation, cooking, and serving for elderly individuals, underprivileged groups, and hospital patients.
- Local team provides all necessary materials.
- Location: ~15-minute walk or 5-minute taxi ride from accommodation.
- Working hours: 8 AM 12:30 PM.

- Volunteers may participate in local festivities or use this time to travel.
- If preferred, dates can be adjusted to avoid disruptions; please contact us for assistance.
